Sir Danny Alexander will set off for Beijing for his new appointment as the Vice-President and Corporate Secretary of Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank.

The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), is a new multilateral financial institution designed to provide financial support for infrastructure development and regional connectivity in Asia. Headquartered in Beijing, the Bank is expected to foster sustainable economic development, create wealth and improve infrastructure connectivity in Asia by investing in infrastructure and other productive sectors. It will also promote regional cooperation and partnership in addressing development challenges by working in close collaboration with other multilateral and bilateral development institution.

Sir Danny was one of the leaders of the first UK coalition government since World War II. He has over 20 years of professional experience. From 2010-2015 he served as Chief Secretary to the UK Treasury, where he secured more than £100 billion of public expenditure savings. He has played an active role in driving international cooperation on tax, trade and transparency during the UK G8 presidency.
